

## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WORK UPDATE QUARTER 4 – JAN- MARCH 2015

<u>William Temple</u> -we have secured funding to buy bees and establish two hives in the grounds. We are now working on getting a partner to secure the site. We have already had some interest from local people in being part of this project. In addition we have a polytunnel which will house some raised beds for growing. This could be herbs or easy to grow vegetables. We are in ongoing dialogue with the Lottery re our Heritage bid. These smaller projects of bees and growing really help to reinforce the vision of making William Temple a welcoming open place which the Lottery are very keen on

<u>St Martin's</u> – is experiencing a spate of vandalism at present. Ongoing dialogue re a new approach to the difficulties at this site and support offered to the progression of the LEP

<u>St Luke's</u> – Main focus has continued to be the Heritage Days and the Food Bank provision. Our food related support has been re-named food for thought A £4000 cheque has been secured to buy a better hot water boiler and toaster and refreshments for the café. This also includes funding to run classes to reeducate and encourage people to make better choices around food and shopping locally and cheaply
