Since April our Team food bank project Food For Thought which is based at St Luke's has been part of the Wythenshawe Food Bank. This has meant that we receive stocks of tins from the distribution centre at the Civic Centre. This is topped up by ongoing donations from congregations which are still gratefully received. Since we joined this scheme we have provided food for 100 people. Based upon the quantity of food that now goes into each parcel this equates to more than £1000 worth of food. The Distribution Centre has good links with supermarkets and food producers for many things now such as cereal, beans, spaghetti, rice, teabags but there are some things that are needed and in short supply. These are the things that we would ask you to consider collecting this year. Rather than keep everything for Food For Thought we will work with the distribution centre to make sure that all of the 7 food banks in the area can benefit too.
